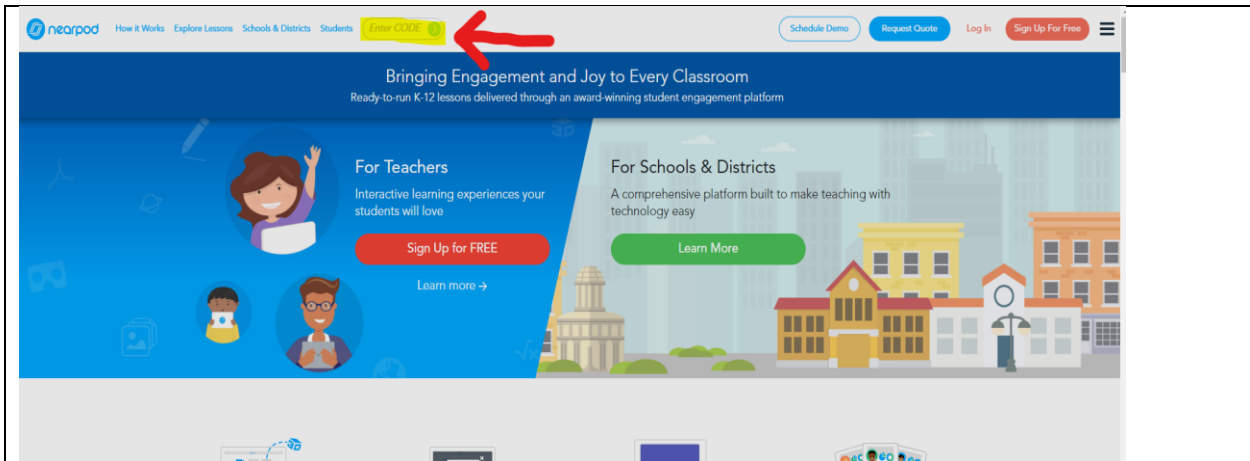
Task 1:

Direct Instruction: Teacher Paced Vs. Student Paced

Nearpod allows the teacher to run “Live lessons,” which are teacher-paced, or “Student-paced.” When teachers select the “Live lesson,” they dictate what students see on their screens. As a teacher moves through a lesson, the slides automatically change on the student device, so they are looking at the element of the presentation that the teacher is talking about or focused on. When the teacher selects “Student-paced,” students can navigate through the multimedia, multimodality lesson at their own pace.

Click on the “My Library” tab from your computer.

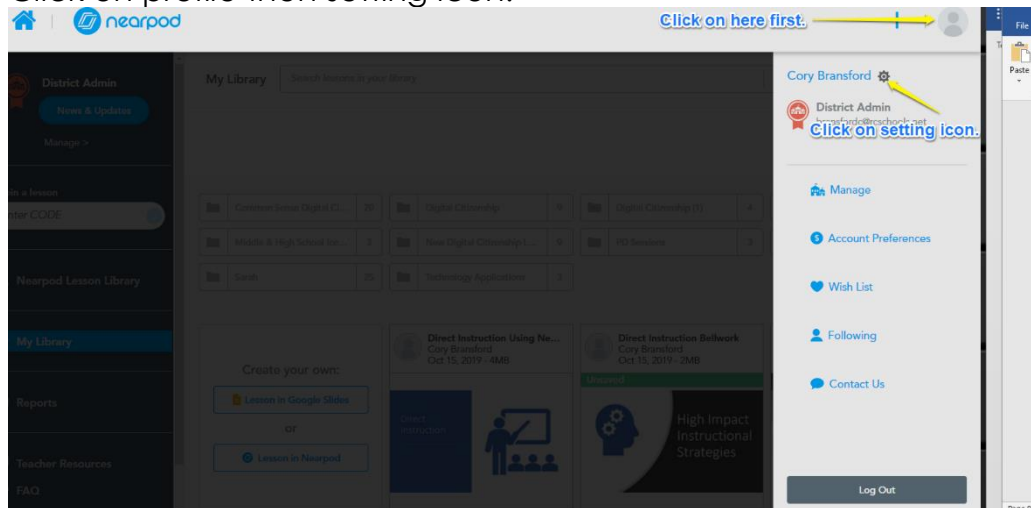
- This is your library that holds the lessons that you have saved from the main Nearpod library.
 - Each lesson has two options
 - 1) Live session - This is how to launch your Teacher Paced lesson.
 - 2) Student paced - allows students to do Nearpod lessons independently or at home.
 - From the “Nearpod Lesson Library” at the left of the page, find at least 1 lesson that you could use in their classrooms in the upcoming weeks.
 - Not everything is free. There is a filter by the search bar on the left that will let you search for lessons. **Does the content and questions align to TN state standards?**
 - If time let participants share what they have found with the group.
- *Please make sure teachers ensure the lessons are aligned to their standards!!!!**

Task 4: Create a new lesson and Upload a PowerPoint


- Find a PPT you have used in class to upload into NearPod
