 - Before arriving on campus, please ask these following Health Screening questions of your student:
 - Do you have a cough?
 - Are you experiencing shortness of breath or difficulty breathing?
 - Do you have a fever?
 - Have you taken any medication to lower a fever?
 - Do you have chills?
 - Are you experiencing muscle pain?
 - Do you have a sore throat?
 - Are you experiencing a new loss of taste or smell?
 - If you answered <u>YES</u> to any of these questions, please seek medical care and do not enter the premises. Contact Nurse Terri at 904-6755, ext. 30909
 - Upon arriving on campus, students will have their temperature taken.
 - Students arrive in the front of the building (Bus Riders or Car Riders).
 - Students will be directed to their grade-level classrooms.
 - Masks must be worn <u>at all times</u>.
 - Social distance protocols will be maintained throughout the school day.
 - Students may bring their lunch or a sack lunch will be provided from the cafeteria.
 - Students will eat in their classrooms to minimize contact with other students.
